

Coupeville Historic Waterfront Association Exterior Enhancement Grant Program Guidelines 2024

Purpose:

CHWA's Exterior Enhancement Grant Program aims to enhance and revitalize buildings and properties in Coupeville's historic commercial district.

This Program stimulates economic vitality and historic preservation in Coupeville's historic commercial district while supporting businesses, buildings, and property owners in achieving their ultimate visions.

The Exterior Enhancement Grant is a matching grant, meaning that the Coupeville Historic Waterfront Association contributes up to 50% cost of eligible improvements for a single building or property.

Eligibility & Requirements:

- Applicants must be businesses, buildings, or property owners physically located in Coupeville's historic commercial district.
- Eligible Improvements include but are not limited to:
 - Signage, painting, windows and doors, lighting, facade improvements, repairs and restorations, landscaping, hardscaping, and creative exterior elements.
- Applicants will obtain permission from the building owner and/or property owner for all exterior improvements.
- When submitting a grant application, planning and research for the corresponding project must be underway so that the project is ready to be completed without major delays.
- Projects shall comply with applicable Town, County, and State codes; it is recommended that Applicants contact the Town of Coupeville's Planning Department before submitting their application to understand if a building permit, a land use permit, or a COA is necessary, as these permits would need to be issued by the Town.

Evaluation Criteria:

- **VISUAL IMPACT (40 points)** The project brings positive change and vibrancy to the downtown historic commercial district of Coupeville.
- **PROJECT VIABILITY (20 points)** Applicants demonstrate the capacity to finish the project on time and within the awarded budget.
- PROJECT PRIORITY (20 points) The project is in a neglected, underutilized, underfunded, or dilapidated place.
- **INNOVATION (20 points)** The project is creative, with unique design or engagement elements contributing to impact.

Application Process & Grant Timeline:

Completed applications are due to the CHWA Community Office by 4:00 pm (PST), Tuesday, May 7th, 2024. Once all applications are received, CHWA's Exterior Enhancement Grant Advisory Committee will meet and review each application based on the Evaluation Criteria listed above. After the review process, the Advisory Committee's recommendations are forwarded to the CHWA Design Committee and the CHWA Board for final approval.

Applicants will receive formal notification regarding project funding from the CHWA Executive Director by Friday, May 24th, 2024. Grant Recipients will then sign a contract to complete the scope of work to be funded, plus any additional project details. Any work undertaken before grants are awarded and contracts for completion are signed is not eligible for reimbursement.

Requests for an extension to complete projects beyond the one (1) year period must be made in writing to the CHWA Executive Director if there are unforeseen circumstances. Extensions will be considered. However, they cannot exceed one (1) year. Past grants have ranged from \$3,000.00 to \$12,000.00. CHWA asks that Grant Recipients publicly acknowledge receiving CHWA Exterior Enhancement Grants if they have websites and/or social media.

Matching Funds:

Coupeville Historic Waterfront Association contributes up to fifty percent (50%) of the cost of eligible improvements for a single building or property through reimbursement after the project is finished. Grant funds cannot be used to pay Applicants for their time or labor. The Ebey's Forever Grant Program is an example of an awarded grant that Applicants can use to match a CHWA's Exterior Enhancement Grant.

Application Assistance:

Assistance from CHWA is available by email and through scheduled project site visits. A site visit with CHWA's Executive Director and Ebey's Landing National Historical Reserve's Preservation Coordinator is highly encouraged. All applications must be at the CHWA Community Office no later than 4:00 pm (PST), Tuesday, May 7th, 2024. Late applications will not be accepted.
